

D. Dragičević completed his undergraduate studies at the Department of Mathematics, University of Zagreb, Croatia, in 2005. He obtained his PhD degree from the Instituto Superior Tecnico, Universidade de Lisboa, Lisbon, Portugal, in 2012. Between September 2015 and December 2017, he was a postdoctoral fellow at the School of Mathematics and Statistics, University of New South Wales, Sydney, Australia. He is currently employed as an Associate Professor at the Faculty of Mathematics, University of Rijeka, Croatia. His research is devoted to the qualitative and quantitative theory of nonautonomous and random dynamical systems. He has delivered more than 30 talks at international mathematical conferences around the world. In 2017, he received the Annual State Award for Young Scientists in the category of natural sciences. Between January 2020 and December 2023, he acted as a principal investigator on the project "Transfer operators, statistical laws, and infinite-dimensional dynamical systems" financed by the Croatian Science Foundation.
